LOCKER CLEANING AND CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Remove all large or abrasive debris from locker surfaces prior to cleaning. Use water or a diluted nonabrasive cleaning detergent (avoid silicon-based ingredients and harsh chemicals such as ammonia and vinegar based products). Use a soft cloth to apply cleaning solution to locker surface. **DO NOT** apply cleaning solution directly to lockers. Gently wipe clean locker surfaces with soft cloth using circular motions. For tougher jobs, use warm water and cleaning detergent and lightly scrub locker surface with a soft bristled brush until surface is clean. Use a separate dry cloth to dry locker surfaces if needed. Deep locker cleanings are recommended 3-6 times per year depending on use.

MATERIAL DISINFECTING

DISINFECTING INSTRUCTIONS

Before beginning disinfecting procedure, be sure to conduct Material Cleaning and Care procedure first. Allow material surface to fully dry. To begin disinfecting procedure, apply an EPA approved disinfectant (LYSOL® Brand I.C.™ Quaternary Disinfectant is recommended). Dilute 1/2 oz of LYSOL® Brand I.C.™ Quaternary Disinfectant per gallon of water. Thoroughly apply solution to material surface using a sponge, cloth, or spray. **DO NOT** soak locker surfaces. Use a separate dry cloth to clean locker surface dry. Repeat disinfecting procedures as needed.
