BULL TILES



RECOMMENDED CLEANING SCHEDULE

The following recommended cleaning schedule is based on the an average sized facility with moderate traffic. Your facility's cleaning needs may vary. Monitor the cleanliness of your Bull Tile flooring and perform additional cleanings as needed to maintain a healthy environment.

DAILY

Remove loose dirt + debris

Clean the floors

Inspect the flooring for excessive wear + damage

EVERY OTHER DAY

Disinfect your Bull Tiles

AS NEEDED

Promptly dry spill

CLEANING PROCEDURES

REGULAR CLEANING

Bull Tiles should be cleaned at least once a day to remove any dirt + bacteria that accumulates during regular use.

1. Remove loose dirt + debris from the Reflex using a broom, a dust mop, or a vacuum. Make sure to remove all debris before proceeding.
2. Clean the surface with an auto-scrubber fitted with a 16 to 24 gauge soft nylon bristle brush or a microfiber mop head. Use a flooring cleaner + degreaser that is recommended for use on rubber flooring.
3. Do not flood the tiles with water when cleaning.
4. Use a wet vacuum to remove the cleaning solution from the flooring + rinse with clean water. Remove the rinse water with a wet vacuum as well.
5. Allow the floor to dry completely before reopening the space to foot traffic.

NOTE: The regular cleaning process may need to be repeated in heavily soiled spaces.

DISINFECTING PROCEDURES

Before disinfecting your Bull Tiles, follow the regular cleaning procedures and ensure the rubber has completely dried.

Follow the dilution / mixing instruction on your preferred disinfectant.

Thoroughly wet the flooring surface with the solution by applying with a cloth, mop, sponge, coarse spray, or soaking. Let the solution remain on the flooring surface for a minimum of ten (10) minutes. Rinse or allow to air dry.

RECOMMENDED CLEANER



Grid recommends you use Diversy Profi Floor Cleaner + Degreaser when you are mopping /scrubbing your Bull Tiles.

Dilute 6-10 oz. per gallon of water.
