VULCAN + VULCAN XL



RECOMMENDED CLEANING SCHEDULE

The following recommended cleaning schedule is based on the an average sized facility with moderate traffic. Your facility's cleaning needs may vary. Monitor the cleanliness of your Vulcan flooring and perform additional cleanings as needed to maintain a healthy environment.

DAILY

Remove loose dirt + debris

Mop the floors

Inspect the flooring for excessive wear + damage

EVERY OTHER DAY

Disinfect your Vulcan flooring

AS NEEDED

Soak + scrub the floors to remove contaminants

Promptly dry spill

CLEANING PROCEDURES

ROUTINE CLEANING

Vulcan flooring should be cleaned at least once a day to remove any dirt + bacteria that accumulates during regular use.

1. Remove loose dirt + debris from the Vulcan flooring using a broom, a dust mop, or a vacuum. Make sure to remove all debris before proceeding.
2. Damp mop the cleaning solution onto the Vulcan flooring with a nylon or rayon mop. Wring the mop between application.
3. Do not flood the Vulcan tiles with cleaning solution when cleaning.
4. Remove minor scuffs while you are mopping, using a white or red pad if needed.
5. Allow the floor to dry completely before reopening the space to foot traffic.

NOTE: The regular cleaning process may need to be repeated in heavily soiled spaces.

DEEP CLEANING PROCEDURES

Vulcan flooring should be deep cleaned when your daily cleaning is not providing the desired results.

1. Remove loose dirt + debris from the Vulcan flooring using a broom, a dust mop, or a vacuum. Make sure to remove all debris before proceeding.
2. Apply the cleaning solution using a nylon or rayon mop, or a pump sprayer. Do not flood the Vulcan tiles with cleaning solution.
3. Allow the cleaning solution to sit on the surface for 5-15 minutes, taking care not to allow the solution to dry.
4. Clean the surface with an auto-scrubber [175 - 350 RPM] fitted with a 16 to 24 gauge soft nylon bristle brush. Set the water volume to the lowest level and activate the vacuum when operating the scrubber.
5. If an auto-scrubber will not fit into your space, thoroughly scrub the flooring with a deck brush.
6. Rinse the floor thoroughly with clean water
7. Allow the floor to dry completely before reopening the space to foot traffic.

NOTE: The deep cleaning process may need to be repeated in heavily soiled spaces.

DISINFECTING PROCEDURES

Before disinfecting your Reflex flooring, follow the regular cleaning procedures and ensure the rubber has completely dried.

Follow the dilution / mixing instruction on your preferred disinfectant.

Thoroughly wet the flooring surface with the solution by applying with a cloth, mop, sponge, coarse spray, or soaking. Let the solution remain on the flooring surface for a minimum of ten (10) minutes. Rinse or allow to air dry.

RECOMMENDED CLEANER

Grid recommends you use Diversy Profi Floor Cleaner + De-greaser when you are mopping /scrubbing your Reflex Flooring.

The dilution ratio varies depending on flooring condition. Follow the direction on the bottle.
